- how the Israel Movement for Progressive Judaism is changing the face of Israeli society

Rabbi Shiryon was the first woman to serve as the rabbi of a congregation in Israel, and has worked in this capacity since 1983. She established her congregation, YOZMA – The Progressive Jewish Community Centre of Modi'in, in 1997, and was instrumental in YOZMA being the first non-Orthodox congregation to receive state funding for its synagogue building.

In 2002, Rabbi Shiryon was elected chairperson of the Council of Progressive Rabbis in Israel (MARAM), where she served for two terms – the first woman to head one of the country's rabbinical bodies. A native New Yorker, Rabbi Shiryon has lived in Israel for over 25 years and works tirelessly for Progressive Judaism to be recognised as a valid and legitimate movement, in eyes of the public and the government of Israel.
